FIDGET SPINNERS!!

As many parents out there will now be aware, Fidget Spinners are the latest craze to hit the shops! And, as with many of the 'latest crazes', this one has become the bane of teacher's lives.



Fidget Spinners are however, more dangerous than some, previous crazes children have developed. They have become a hindrance during lessons, a distraction rather than of any help to the children. Out on the yard, children are throwing them and pulling them from each other and, as with any craze, when such items are brought into school, there is always the possibility of them getting lost or broken.

There have instances on social media, showing adults and children alike, who have suffered injuries as serious as almost losing an eye, because of them.

To this end, therefore, **Fidget Spinners will be now banned from the school site completely, in order to maintain the safety of everyone.**

Please, therefore, do not bring them into school or allow other children to play with them whilst on the school site, either before or after school. The safety of *your* children is paramount to us.

If a child requires the use of a fidget toy in school, then school will provide them with an appropriate device which is safe for use and which meets the need of the child.

RESPECTING OTHERS

It has been brought to our attention that some members of staff are being repeatedly approached by parents about school matters whilst staff are out of school, in their own time, undertaking their own, private activities.
