**Are you concerned about keeping your child safe online?**

On **Monday 22nd May** we are holding a parent/carer information meeting where you can find out about:

- The Online Lives of Children in Sheffield including their likes, dislikes and worries.
- The risks that this online activity poses to young people, particularly the behaviour that puts them at risk from grooming, extremism, bullying and inaccurate information.

Sue Finnigan, a *very experienced* member of Sheffield City Council eLearning Team, will be talking about **Children's Online Lives** and '**How to Keep them Safe**'. There will also be opportunities to ask questions and Sue will share ideas for practical places from where to get support and advice.

The meeting will **start at 5pm, in the School Hall**, and should run until *approximately* 7pm, but may actually finish earlier than this depending upon the time taken to answer parents' questions.

**We hope that as many parents/carers as possible will take the opportunity to join us and learn more about how to keep our children safe online.**
