We would like to thank the three parents who came to hear Sue Finnigan talk about how to keep your children safe online. Thanks, also, to the staff who gave up their time to help organise this event and be there on the night. Below are some comments from these parents about the event:

Thank you for the invite to the internet security workshop that was presented by Sheffield City Council. I have always considered myself to be quite aware of the types of social media that kids are accessing today but after the session I was quite surprised on how much I didn't know. I think what struck me was the age that kids are starting on these types of apps and what they have to say about them. I had never really thought of the use of gaming systems as part of this before the session. I found the event very informative and would encourage all parents regardless of their child's age to attend. It has spurred me to have more conversations about internet safety with my daughter and to make sure that she is comfortable talking to us and that she won't be in trouble and "lose her tech".

I would like to thank you, Sacred heart School and the presenter for organising the e-safety meeting on the 22/05/2017.

I found the meeting to be very informative and the presenter was excellent.

I did not realise how unsafe and vulnerable our children are / can be online.

The statistics illustrating the risks and dangers that our children can be exposed to online were shocking especially with the advancement of all the different apps (even the most seemingly innocent ones) that children use on daily basis.

The presenter was great at providing information, advise and guidance on how to protect and educate our children about online safety.

I know the School is doing the best they can to promote online safety awareness at School but attending the meeting enabled me to understand that it has to be a joint effort and we as parents have a big role to play in order to protect our children.
