
One day, Peter asked Jesus, "How many times should I forgive someone who sins against me? Should I forgive him seven times?" I imagine that Peter was pretty proud of himself for being willing to forgive someone seven times. Jesus answered, "Not seven times, but seventy seven times!" I think Jesus knew that if he said we should forgive seventy seven times, we would never be able to keep count and we would forgive over, and over again, just as he forgives us. People are all different, but we all have one thing in common - we all make mistakes! And the chances are, through our lives, we will make a lot of mistakes. God sent Jesus to die on the cross – so that all of our mistakes could be erased. When we do something wrong, we can ask God to forgive us and because of Jesus, He will erase our mistakes and we can start over again, and again, and again. Unlike any erasers you may have at home, God's eraser never wears out! So it doesn't matter who we are or what we look like - we all need God's forgiveness. We also need to remember that Jesus taught that we are to forgive others too for their mistakes - just as God forgives us.

Virtue to Live By


Our Current Virtue to Live By is Love of Learning
