# 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A

In the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus tells a story to show how different people obey what God has called them to do. In Jesus' parable of the two sons, the father asked both sons to go and work in his vineyard. One son answered, "No," but afterwards thinks better of it, and goes off to do the work his father has asked him to do. The other son answered "yes", but in the end, doesn't go. In telling the story, Jesus wanted us to realise that what we do is more important than what we say we will do. Jesus wants us to answer, "Yes," when he tells us to "Love one another," but what he really wants is for us to actually love one another! And Jesus wants us to answer, "Yes," when he says, "Follow me," but what he really wants is for us to actually follow him! So remember this - 'actions speak louder than words'.... There are lots of things to distract us from doing what we say we are going to do - playing, reading a good book maybe, making something, watching TV. But when you find yourself faced with a decision to make, try to ask yourself "what would God want me to do?" And when you know the answer - do it!


