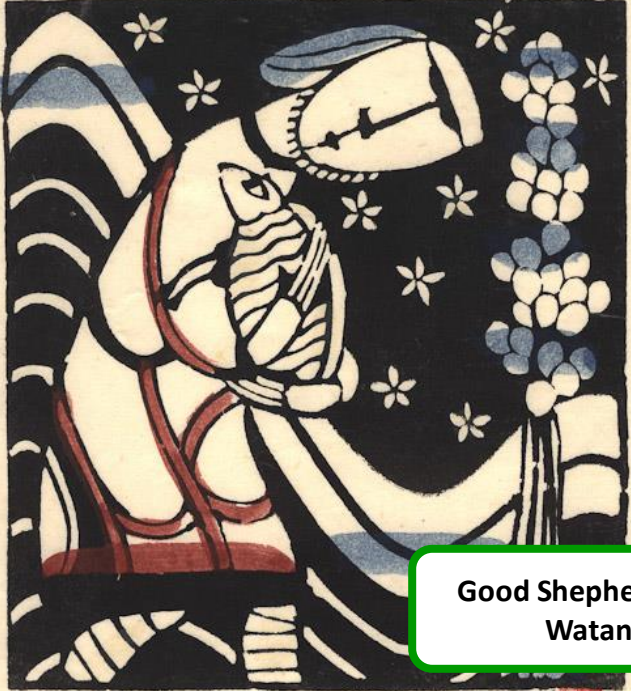


Building Bridges
