The readings for this week teach us about the presence of God's spirit, the right use of wealth, and the importance of recognizing good works in others. These lessons remind us to stay humble, be generous, and be inclusive. Reflecting on these themes helps us grow in our faith.

In the Gospel, the disciples see someone casting out demons in Jesus' name and try to stop him. Jesus tells them not to stop him because anyone who is not against us is for us. Jesus emphasises that good works done in His name are valuable.

This lesson shows us the importance of being inclusive in our ministry. We should not be quick to judge others who are doing good work, even if they are not part of our group. Jesus values all efforts done in His name.

By recognizing and supporting the good works of others, we build a stronger community. We are all working towards the same goal. This spirit of inclusiveness strengthens our faith and unity.
