In the Gospel this week, Bartimaeus, a blind man, calls out to Jesus. Despite the crowd trying to silence him, he persists. His faith leads to his healing. Jesus stops and asks Bartimaeus what he wants. Bartimaeus asks to see again. Jesus tells him that his faith has healed him, and Bartimaeus immediately regains his sight.

Bartimaeus' story shows the power of faith. Our faith can lead to healing and new beginnings. Bartimaeus did not just gain his sight; he chose to follow Jesus. Bartimaeus has the faith and courage to leave his cloak and everything behind to follow Jesus. Jesus told Bartimaeus to go his way, but he chose to follow Jesus instead. This shows his complete trust and dedication. Bartimaeus teaches us to follow Jesus no matter the cost.

Prayer Intentions: As we come to the end of Black History Month, we pray for justice for members of our community who experience racism, and for the strength of all those who stand against it. May we be proud of our communities, and ever mindful of the need to work for racial justice and reconciliation in society.
