The Gospel this week tells the story of a steward who mismanages his master’s wealth and then acts shrewdly to secure his future. Though his motives are selfish, his actions show the value of generosity. Even a man driven by greed can see the importance of building relationships and gaining favour through kindness.

This parable challenges us to think about our own use of resources. Everything we have comes from God, and we are stewards of His blessings. Do we use what we have wisely? Do we share generously, or do we hold on tightly, thinking only of ourselves?

Jesus teaches that if even the greedy can recognise the benefits of generosity, His disciples should be even more willing to give. Our faith calls us to be kind and compassionate, not for personal gain, but because we know that God has given us everything. By sharing with others, we reflect God’s love and fulfill His call to care for those around us.

This reading invites us to align our lives more closely with God’s ways. By caring for the poor, praying for others, and being faithful stewards of what we have, we can live as children of light. Let us take these lessons to heart and strive to live each day with justice, generosity, and love for others.

Prayer Intentions: We pray that world leaders also strive to live and lead with justice, generosity and love in order to make decisions that place the most vulnerable at the heart
