In the Gospel this week, Jesus tells the parable of Lazarus and the rich man. This story is a clear reminder of what can happen when we focus only on ourselves. The rich man enjoyed his wealth while ignoring the suffering of Lazarus, who was right outside his door. After death, the rich man faced judgment, and Lazarus found peace.

Jesus's message is clear: wealth and comfort are not the problem, but selfishness is. When we fail to see the suffering of others, we turn away from God's call. The rich man's downfall wasn't his wealth but his choice to do nothing for Lazarus.

This parable invites us to reflect on our own choices. Are we aware of the needs around us? Do we use what we have to help others? The Gospel reminds us to see those in need and to act with love and compassion.

Prayer Intentions: Lord, help us to see beyond our comforts and to respond to those in need with a generous heart. Teach us to treasure mercy and compassion over wealth, so that we may truly participate in Your work and know the joy of Your Kingdom.
